She was installed as Senior Minister of North Congregational Church in February 2011, after serving as Associate Minister of North Church since 1998. She is a graduate of the Methodist Theological School in Ohio (Master of Divinity – 1999, Doctor of Ministry – 2015), and the University of Michigan (BA 1975). She has served as president of the Southeast Michigan Congregational Clergy and moderator of the Southeastern Michigan Association of Congregational Churches. She also served as Historian for the National Association of Congregational Christian Churches, and board member of the Congregational Library and Archives. Mimi was the long-time Coordinator of the Farmington/Farmington Hills/West Bloomfield CROP Walk and is past president of the Farmington Area Interfaith Association.
